

## Privacy Notice

This Information is provided pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 - General Data Protection Regulation. According to the aforementioned Regulation, the processing of personal data will be based on principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency, and confidentiality.

We therefore provide the following information:

### 1) IDENTITY AND CONTACT DETAILS OF THE DATA CONTROLLER

The “Data Controller” is Humanitas University (or Hunimed), with registered office in Pieve Emanuele (MI), Via Rita Levi Montalcini, 4, in the person of the *pro tempore* Delegated Director.

### 2) CONTACT DETAILS OF THE DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

### 3) CATEGORIES OF DATA, PURPOSES, AND LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

The processing carried out relates to the categories of data, purposes, and legal bases described below:

- A. Email address to verify the possibility of registration to the Alumni Community.
- B. Personal identification and telephone contact details, data relating to the course of study and professional career processed for the creation of the profile. Information relating to your professional career that may appear in your profile has only been included if previously provided by you or made public by you on professional social networks (e.g., LinkedIn).
- C. Personal identification and contact details for sending information and promotional communications concerning courses, events, and initiatives dedicated to the community, such as reunions or networking events.
- D. Personal identification and contact details for any defensive purposes.

For the purposes referred to under letters A) and B), the processing is necessary for the execution of a contract and/or pre-contractual measures, pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, letter b) of EU Regulation 679/2016.

For the purposes referred to under letter C), the data will be processed on the basis of explicit consent, pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, letter a) of EU Regulation 679/2016, and the failure to provide such consent does not in any way prevent registration. In any case, it is always possible to withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent given before such withdrawal. To withdraw consent, select the “unsubscribe” option available at the bottom of the communications.

For the purposes referred to under letter D), data processing is necessary for the pursuit of the legitimate interest of the Data Controller consisting in the protection of its rights.

### 4) RECIPIENTS AND CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA

Considering the purposes of the Alumni Community, personal data will be visible to all registered members.

The processing of personal data will be carried out by appropriately authorized Humanitas University staff, as well as by third parties having a contractual or conventional relationship with Humanitas University for administrative and institutional purposes or for the execution and assistance of the services provided, acting as Data Controllers or Data Processors. For technical and other reasons, your personal data may be transferred outside the European Union and, in particular, to countries for which the European Commission has expressly authorized the transfer, or which have provided adequate guarantees in accordance with the legislation in force from time to time. ## **5) RETENTION PERIOD OF PERSONAL DATA**

Personal data will be retained until membership of the Community ends through the deletion of the account. With regard to the sending of communications, personal data will be retained until consent is withdrawn.

Personal identification and contact details for any defensive purposes will be retained for the duration of the out-of-court and/or judicial proceedings and, in any case, until the expiry of the terms of enforceability of judicial protections and/or appeals.

## **6) RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT**

At any time, you can request information on how your data have been acquired, verify that they are accurate, complete, up-to-date, and properly stored, and exercise the rights provided under Articles 15 et seq. of EU Regulation 2016/679 (right of access to your data, right to rectification or erasure, right to restriction of processing or to object to processing, right to data portability, right to withdraw your consent) by writing to [privacy@humanitas.it](mailto:privacy@humanitas.it) or [privacy.humanitas@pec.it](mailto:privacy.humanitas@pec.it).

If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the law, you may lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority. You also have the right to appeal to the competent judicial authority.
